



### DRISHTI - "JAL HI JEEWAN HAI"


3rd January 2022


On 3rd January 2022 volunteers of the NGO organized an interactive session on the topic "Jal hi jeewan hai" for Arjun camp students as part of the Drishti Project. There was a limitation for the age group children who are 9-13 years of age can participate in this activity. The class was held on the grounds of Arjun Camp's temple. We conducted our activity 'JAL HI JEEWAN HAI' which aimed mainly to make them aware of th need to save water and also how they can do the same.

Firstly we taught them that out of 71% of the water present on Earth only 0.025% is drinkable so that's why there is a need to save water, in addition, we gave them some examples like turning off the tap while brushing, saving rainwater to use them for domestic works, etc. Then we asked them their views on how they can save water and the majority of them answered ways like reuse of rainwater and not to use the shower for bathing. To make class fun and interactive we conducted an activity to make posters on 'SAVE WATER'.









Ms. Nisha told the women that she would attempt to settle all of the concerns as soon as possible. Ms. Nisha was pleased to see women attempting to learn new skills and prepare themselves to be self-employed, and she was delighted to be a part of such a groundbreaking session and assist people with their concerns.



### 1st March 2022

On March 1, 2022, Hamari Pahchan collaborated with The Palette to have a fun day with four children from various slum neighborhoods. Before taking the kids to the cafe, we got permission from their guardians. The kids were ecstatic to go to the cafe and spend the day with our team members and each other.

The purpose of the day was to allow children from low-income families to experience and explore activities that privileged people do regularly. We believed that this would encourage them to better their living conditions. We also hope that in the future, we will be able to cooperate with more warm-hearted people/businesses to help more youngsters have such positive and enjoyable experiences.

We took four students but with the support of others, we will be able to accommodate 40 or 400 children for such an incredible experience.





### **WOMEN'S DAY**

### 8th March 2022

On March 8, 2022, Hamari Pahchan collaborated with Air India to celebrate Women's Day. The event took place at the Centaur Hotel. We were given a venue to promote our non-profit organization as well as our campaigns for change and equality.

### UMBRELLA DISTRIBUTION DRIVE


### 9th April 2022

8th June - 11th June 2022


The survey aimed to get a brief about the legal issues and the legal aid that the people need which shall help us in shaping the whole purpose of our Legal awareness camp.


The team could reach approximately 50 houses in the Collie camp, Vasant Vihar, and got more than 20 legal issues registered with Hamari Pahchan.



### 23rd JULY 2022

ON 23RD JULY, 4 VOLUNTEERS FROM HAMARI PAHCHAN NGO VISITED BHANWARSINGH CAMP, VASANT VIHAR FOR AN INTERACTIVE SESSION ON MENSTRUAL HYGIENE WITH ISHA. THE EVENT'S MAIN AIM WAS TO SPREAD KNOWLEDGE ABOUT MENSTRUAL HYGIENE AND HELP WOMEN KNOW MORE ABOUT THEIR BODIES. THE EVENT STARTED AT 1:00 PM, ISHA WAS WELL KNOWN AMONGST THE LADIES FOR CARRYING OUT PREVIOUS DRIVES THERE.

THE WOMEN HAD NUMEROUS INQUIRIES ON MENSTRUAL HYGIENE THROUGHOUT THE SESSION. ISHA EDUCATED ALL THE WOMEN ON IMPORTANT TOPICS RELATING TO MENSTRUAL HYGIENE SUCH AS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN DIFFERENT BLOOD COLORS, WHAT CAN A PERSON EAT AT SUCH A TIME, HOW CAN THEY REDUCE PAIN DURING PERIODS, ETC.

# RAKHI MAKING COMPETITON

### 10th AUGUST 2022

ON THE 10TH OF AUGUST, 5 VOLUNTEERS FROM HAMARI PAHCHAN VISITED BHANWAR SINGH CAMP, VASANT VIHAR TO CONDUCT A RAKHI-MAKING COMPETITION WITH SOME UNDERPRIVILEGED CHILDREN.

THE MAIN AIM OF THE EVENT WAS TO GIVE THE CHILDREN A CHANCE TO HAVE A FUN-FILLED DAY. EACH CHILD'S RAKHI WAS PRESENTED TO THE PARTICIPANTS AND ONCE EVERYONE HAD DESIGNED THEIR RAKHIS' THE VOLUNTEERS DELIBERATED ON THE BEST RAKHI.

THE TOP 5 RAKHI DESIGNS WERE AWARDED WITH A STATIONARY KIT AND A CHOCOLATE. THE REST OF THE PARTICIPANTS WERE GIVEN CHIPS OR A JUICE BOX. BEFORE DISPERSING ALL THE GIRLS TIED RAKHIS TO THE BOYS AS A PRECURSOR TO RAKSHA BANDHAN. THE EVENT ENDED WITH A LOT OF SMILING FACES.



## ENVIRONMENT BOOK DISTRIBUTION

### 1st October 2022

ON 1ST OCTOBER OUR NGO CONDUCTED AN EVENT TO GUIDE STUDENTS AROUND THE AGE OF 13 - 20 YRS ON ENVIRONMENTAL AWARENESS.

AMONG BOOKS THE STUDENTS WE DISTRIBUTED THAT SOME FUN ACTIVITIES THAT COULD HELP AND CONTAINED EDUCATE THEM ON WHAT TO DO TO KEEP THEIR ENVIRONMENT A BETTER PLACE TO LIVE. THE BOOK WAS COMPILED IN SUCH A WAY THAT STUDENTS COULD FOLLOW EASILY. WE EXPLAINED TO THEM THE OVERVIEW OF THE BOOK SO THAT THEY COULD GET IDEA OF THE CONTENTS OF THE BOOK. ALONG WITH THE CHILDREN WE EVEN TOOK AN OATH THAT WE WOULD DO OUR BEST TO PRESERVE OUR SURROUNDINGS.







THEY INITIALLY ATTEMPTED TO LEARN FROM PAKHI AUNTY. SHE INSTRUCTS THEM ON HOW TO SEW. SHE ALSO TAUGHT THEM HOW TO MAKE ITEMS WITH CROATIAN MATERIALS.

OUR TRAINER, MRS. ZEBA, TAUGHT THEM DIFFERENT TYPES OF STITCHES AFTER A FEW DAYS OF PRACTICE. SHE TAUGHT THEM HOW TO CUT FELT WOOL INTO THE VARIOUS FORMS OF THE COASTER AFTER THEY HAD PRACTICED THEIR STITCHES. WE PROVIDED THEM WITH THE MATERIALS TO PRODUCE FELT WOOL COASTERS, AS WELL AS PRACTICE TIME, SO THAT THEY COULD LEARN THE BASICS OF KNITTING WITHOUT MAKING TOO MANY MISTAKES, AND OUR TRAINER CHECKED AND LED THEM TO MAKE BETTER COASTERS.




### COVID AWARENESS SESSION AND REPUBLIC DAY

IN THE END, ALL THE CHILDREN WERE HAPPY AND SUGGESTED ONE TOPIC FOR THE NEXT SESSION.








21st January, 2023

THE WORKSHOP AIMED TO EDUCATE CHILDREN ON THE IMPORTANCE OF THESE THREE PRINCIPLES IN CREATING A SUSTAINABLE FUTURE AND TO PROMOTE THE IDEA OF CREATING REUSABLE ITEMS. CLASS STARTED WITH AN INTRODUCTION TO THE THREE RS AND THEIR SIGNIFICANCE IN OUR DAILY LIVES.





### 8th April 2023

ON APRIL 8TH, 2023, WE TOOK A WORKSHOP ON STEM SCIENCE AND HELPED UNDERPRIVILEGED CHILDREN. THE WORKSHOP WAS HELD IN A SLUM AREA AND WAS ATTENDED BY CHILDREN BETWEEN THE AGES OF 8 AND 12.




## LGBTQ
